A Tribute to Corine Crabb

In 1941, when St. Bartholomew was established, at the age of 16 – Corine Crabb began playing in the original church of St. Bartholomew – the ground floor of the school building next door.

Corine began an adult choir of 10-15 members and in 1959, Ruth Schoenbachler joined her in directing the choir. In 1988, Corine's sister, Alice McCall became the music director. In 1992, Chuck and Gina Priddy became the Music Directors and continue to enlist the help of Corine Crabb.

Corine has been involved in Music Ministry prior to Vatican II when the masses were said in Latin. Corine has played music for many, many liturgies, weddings and funerals. She played the music for the very first wedding in the church – Louise and Frank Heil in 1942.

Throughout the years, she has been an inspiration for several organists, keyboardists and choir members. She has worked side by side with Sr. Jean Paschal, Ruth Schoenbachler,

Martha Eberenz, Jane Grimm, Alice McCall, Kathy Fleischer, Jenni McCall, Chuck & Gina Priddy, Bill Stemmle, Phil Duvall, Don Mohr, Patrick and Patrick Hughes — right down to her youngest prodigies — Amanda Haas Mattingly and Jacob Priddy.

Youth Ministry - Deacon Frank

The Youth Ministry Program at St Bartholomew and St Ignatius has been established and is seeing signs of growth. We have decided that a combined Youth Ministry program will be more beneficial to the youth of both parishes rather than to have separate youth minis-

tries. We offer a Junior High Youth Ministry program for grades 6-8 and a Senior High Youth Ministry program for grades 9-12. The meetings are held every Sunday except the first Sunday of the month from 12:30 to 2:00 p.m. for Junior High and from 2:00 to 3:30 p.m. for Senior High. There are 6 junior high students and 8 Senior High Students currently attending.

We have 16 Youth from St. Bartholomew and St Ignatius attending the National Catholic Youth Conference this November in Indianapolis.

Confirmation Preparation

Baptism, the Eucharist, and the sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the "sacraments of Christian initiation, whose unity must be safeguarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. -Catechism of the Catholic Church 1285

Confirmation Prep program is now offered in two levels. Level One is a refresher programmer for those students that have not had the opportunity to attend regular religious education in the past. Level two Confirmation Prep is for those who have attended religious education on a regular basis and are ready to concentrate on the Sacrament of Confirmation. We have 26 Level one students and have 28 Level two students. The students meet every Wednesday from 6:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m.

Centro Pastoral Sacrament Update

To date, Deacon Frank has baptized 87 children in the last two years since accepting his diaconate role here at St Bartholomew.

Currently, there are nine adults enrolled in the Spanish Language RCIA. The majority of these candidates have been baptized, but still require the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation to complete their initiation.

There are four Spanish couples currently participating in preparing for the sacrament of Matrimony.

Altar Servers

We now have nine altar servers participating at our 11:15 liturgy and two participating at our 4:00 liturgy on Saturday. The ministry is growing and it seems that every week some new young person is asking to become part of this ministry.


